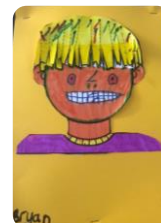
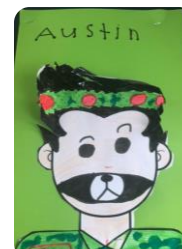
Cross Country
