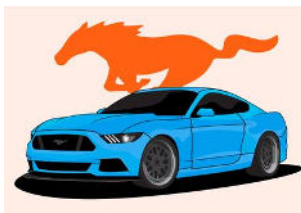


### **Mustang Day**
